The search committee met on Thursday, January 19, and began the process of our search for a new Children's and Family Minister. The Search Committee, consisting of David Uptagrafft, Frank Fitzgerald, Kerry Williams and Lee Boles (Andy Herron was not able to attend) met with Pam Clasgens, Pastor Paul and Dr. Dale Braxton. Dale led our meeting and began with a workbook and timeline of the Search and Call process.

Our first order of business as a committee is to complete the congregational profile. This profile tells not only the demographics of our congregation and our history but also gives a prospective minister a glimpse into what we see as our future. This profile will ensure that we match with the best possible fit for our children and families. You will have several opportunities in the next few weeks to join in discussions about this future, but first I would like for you to prayerfully consider several items:

- What has God called us to be as a congregation?
- How is this congregation relevant to the needs of each other and the local community?
- How does this congregation bear witness in tangible ways to God's healing, welcoming and reconciling presence?

As you pray over these questions, I ask you to envision how our new minister can enable First Christian to answer God's Call in Huntsville, in Alabama, and in our world.

#### **COMMUNITY FREE DENTAL CLINIC**

The February local outreach focus for First Christian Church is raising funds for the Community Free Dental Clinic located on Whitesburg Drive. This clinic is a 501(c)(3) non profit with the mission to provide free quality dental care and education to low income, uninsured residents of Madison County. The work is done by appointment only, with extractions and a limited number of cleanings and fillings being the focus.

The poverty level in Madison county is 13.6%. Many of these are elderly on fixed incomes with broken, painful teeth. If left untreated, infected gums or abscesses often result which can be life threatening. Since the clinic opened in 2013, over 8,600 people have been treated including many veterans. Most recently, senior UAB dental students travel to Huntsville three times a year to work in the clinic in supervised settings much as they do at the UAB Dental School in Birmingham. This addition of professional help has greatly expanded the ability of the clinic to fill appointments for those in need.

Please consider the Community Free Dental Clinic as yet another worthy cause to support here in Madison County. Even though the professional services offered are done by volunteers, there is significant overhead necessary with such items as operating cost for the clinic, Personal Protective Equipment for the staff and numbing agents for the comfort of the patient.
