COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROJECT FOR JUNE: WE CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE!

The Community Outreach Committee's project for June is collecting financial donations for the Foster Care Unit of DHR (Department of Human Resources) to purchase gift cards to Walmart and other places as requested by DHR. There are over 430 children in foster care in Madison County and funding is not adequate to cover all their needs. These children are in care through no fault of their own; they have been abused and neglected by those who should have protected them.

Community Outreach, with your help, would like to ensure that the Foster Care Unit has funds on hand to use throughout the year to help our children who are suffering physically, mentally, and emotionally. Our 29th home is in the planning stages. Once the foundation is poured, we will start building the walls in the Habitat Warehouse. All volunteers are required to attend a safety meeting on zoom. I went by the "Habitat Village" site on Meridian opposite the grammar school. Site preparation is going on to establish 16 additional lots for the next homes to be built there. One street has already been built out.
