Ukraine Response – Special Collection

It's been more than four months since Russian troops invaded Ukraine. While the news coverage may have

slowed, the destruction, casualties, and horror have not ceased. The humanitarian crisis grows daily, with repercussions that will be felt for years.

The Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) will continue to serve for as long as needed. Week of Compassion ministry and ecumenical partners are addressing the immediate needs of refugees, providing shelter, food, medical and psychosocial care, education, and vocational resources. Over the next months and years, that assistance will continue as some evacuees choose to return home when they are able, and others resettle more permanently into new locations and lives.
