# **HABITAT HOUSE NO 28 UPDATE**

Our home build is progressing slowly due to extreme heat at the work site, which restricts how long we work each day. The brick masons have just about completed the



house wrap. The insulation is about 1/3 completed. After inspection, the drywall board will be installed by the contractors and then painting will begin.

After 35 years of serving Madison County, Habitat has expanded into Limestone County and changed its name to Habitat for Humanity of the River Valley. They have served over 300 families since 1987.

Our church has helped build 27 homes and is working on our 28th. What a great outreach program this has been thanks to the late Rev. Dr. Harold Dowler for loading us on the bus, taking us to an unfinished house, and challenging us to complete it! Thanks also to all of you who worked, donated, and prayed for our success. Thanks, church!
