Love - December 24

"God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.¹⁷ In this is love perfected with us, that we may have confidence for the day of judgment, because as he is so are we in this world.¹⁸ There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and he who fears is not perfected in love" 1 John4:16-18 (RSV)

This verse is one that plays through my head on a regular basis; as Oprah Winfrey said, "I believe that every single event in life happens in an opportunity to choose love over fear." I find myself continually choosing between fear and love- will I allow fear of rejection to outweigh the love of reaching out to a friend? Will I allow fear of financial insecurity to outweigh giving to those in need? If love knows no fear, then every choice I make is an opportunity to "abide in love", reject fear, and continually be "perfected in love." In this effort



to discipline myself to love, I find it helpful to identify which of my fears is attempting to hold me back from the loving choice. Am I afraid of rejection? Of change? Of insecurity? Of pain? Being aware of the fear helps me to overcome it. Next time you feel a reluctance to make the loving choice, ask yourself if that reluctance is fear, and then choose love over fear.

Gracious God, we know that your promises are secure but that often you give answers that do not meet our expectations. In the birth of a child we have seen your glory, now send your Spirit to the wild corners of our hearts. Grant us wisdom and understanding that we will overcome our fear and spread the good news that has transformed our lives. Amen.
