STORIES OF BAPTISM

Is it spring yet? It sure feels like it. The last few days we opened the windows in our home for the first time to let in the fresh air. Flowers have begun to bloom in our yard and even the deer returned, much to Patti's pleasure. Of course when I look at the forecast for the next few weeks I know there is still cold weather on the horizon. Winter has not let go of its grip, yet this week is a reminder that spring, and new life, is on its way and it has filled us with hope.

With that in mind we also look at the church calendar, and while we are still in the season of Lent, we also know that Easter is right around the corner. For church life this means we get ready for Easter Egg hunts, picnics, and baptisms. Lent began as an opportunity for new Christians to ready themselves for Baptism. They took the 40 days before Easter to study, reflect, pray, fast, and open themselves to a new way of life and a new understanding of faith. In our congregation we also ask young people, who would like to begin their journey of faith, to attend baptism classes and prepare for this celebration on Easter Sunday. If you have not been baptized, but would like to be, we invite you to join our class or talk to me about individual mentoring.

Last year my son Joe went through baptism classes and I was a very proud father when he made the decision to join the church and the Kingdom of God. I was also able to baptize my daughter Abby, even if she claims I held her down longer than the other candidates. I just think she needed a little more spiritual cleansing. Every time I am involved in a baptism ceremony I remember my own baptism, how cold the water was, the look on my father's face, so serious but also filled with joy, how it seemed to take no time at all and then I was walking up the stairs, wet and filled with new hope.

This year, I would like for you to reflect on your own experience of baptism or confirmation. What do you remember? What made that day special? How did it change your faith and your connection with God? If you feel led, please share these stories with our baptism class. I am sure the young people there will want to hear about your experience because when they are baptized their lives will become a part of the great story of God's redeeming love, one that we are called to share and one that never ends.
