#### **TAKING A JOURNEY WITH GOD**

John Steinbeck once wrote about his travels in America, "I did not take the trip, the trip took me." This reminded me that in the same way God is not ours, we are God's and the Church is not ours, we are the Church's. In the gospel of John Chapter 15 Jesus told the disciples that, "You did not choose me but I choose you. And I appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last so that the Father will give you whatever you ask him in my name."

This powerful statement reminds us that everything we have, everything we are, and everything we will be belongs to God. We are chosen to bear the fruit, the good news of Jesus Christ, to the ends of the earth, and when we look beyond ourselves we find this is our mission.

One of the things I looked at very closely when making my decision to come to First Christian Church was your Spiritual Strategic Journey plan. The Rev. Dr. Richard L. Hamn, the consultant for the strategic plan, highlighted six outcomes in the results.

- 1. An energized, Christ-centered congregation led by the Holy Spirit to do God's will in our community.
- 2. Growth: Spiritual Growth of the congregation and membership growth.
- 3. A strong sense of membership connection.
- 4. Enhancing and Expanding Outreach programs, local, regional and global.
- 5. Stewardship broadened to reflect commitment to God's purpose for our congregation.
- 6. Maintain, enhance and expand our facilities to encourage existing programs and future growth.

While the time period for the Strategic Plan has come to an end, I believe that these outcomes are still relevant for our congregation today. Our new leadership team will be elected by the congregation on May 5<sup>th</sup>. In this time of transition, as these new leaders fill their respective positions in July, we need to make sure that they receive our support. It is my hope that these new leaders will bring a new vision for the life of our congregation that will lead us further along our Spiritual Strategic Plan and allow for God to work in innovative ways within the church.

If we are God's and we know that we are all a part of the Body of Christ we must celebrate the positive steps we have already taken, and work with each other to develop our growing edges. It is exciting to be a member of a church that takes its mission to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ seriously; now we ask God to take us, use us, and create the church that God wants us to be. Amen.
