### BUT HIS DISCIPLES FINISHED HIS WORK...

Some weeks ago I read a story about composer Giacomo Puccini who wrote a number of famous operas including *La bohème*, *Tosca*, and *Madama Butterfly*. In 1922 he was stricken by cancer while working on his last opera *Turandot*. Puccini called his students together and said to them, "If I don't finish *Turandot*, I want you to finish it for me." Shortly afterwards he passed away.

Puccini's students worked diligently and soon completed the opera. In 1926 the world premiere of *Turandot* was performed in Milan with Arturo Toscanini directing. Everything went beautifully until the opera reached the point where Puccini had been forced to put down his pen. Tears ran down Toscanini's face. He stopped the music, put down his baton, turned to the audience and cried out, "Thus far the Master wrote, but he died."

A vast silence filled the opera house. Toscanini picked up the baton again, smiled through his tears and exclaimed, "But his disciples finished his work." When *Turandot* ended, the audience broke into thunderous applause. No one at the performance ever forgot that moment.

As Disciples of Christ we are called to continue the work of Jesus. Often that work can be difficult, long and labor intensive, but nothing feels better than to look back and realize that you have helped to create something that will live on in the hearts and minds of those who participated. The wonderful thing about our church is that we do this every day. We open our building to the community allowing groups that fill a desperate need in our city a place to meet, we open our church so that all are welcome and all can find a place to worship, and we open our hearts by giving so that our outreach commitments can be met.

July 16<sup>th</sup> - 20<sup>th</sup> we have another opportunity to open our church and our hearts to the world. We are excited about Vacation Bible School this year. The theme is *Shipwrecked: Rescued by Jesus*. The VBS material focuses on deepening children's faith by helping them discover that Jesus cares about them personally and can rescue them in life's toughest circumstances. It also reminds us of our need to help others and provide Christ's message of hope and reconciliation. We still need volunteers to teach the children, provide healthy snacks, and provide a great atmosphere by donating prizes, helping us decorate, and welcoming the children and their parents. It is my hope that we not only offer an opportunity for renewal to the participants of Vacation Bible School but that our church is renewed by our efforts to continue the work of the Master. Thanks be to God, Amen.

Currently the Alabama-Northwest Florida Region is sponsoring three new congregations-in-formation and talks are in the early stages regarding a possible fourth new start-up. There is great excitement when a group begins to come together around the vision of becoming a new congregation. There is an eagerness to share the message and to invite others to be a part of the new church. The Alabama-Northwest Florida Region is greatly blessed by the energy and spirit that comes to us through our new congregations In the early stages of a new church start, funding from the Regional Church is essential. Before an offering plate has ever been passed, there is a need for funding to secure appropriate leadership and a place to meet. There are also publicity and equipment costs.
