Telephone Volunteers Needed

A service of Interfaith Mission Service and its member congregations, FOODLine food ministry coordinates among 15 - 20 local food pantries to provide short-term, emergency relief to families with immediate food needs. Families are eligible for help twice in a 12-month period with FOODLine telephone volunteers operating as a clearing house between local callers in need and area food pantries. FOODLine volunteers answer calls Monday through Friday from 9:00 to 11:30 am and in the afternoon Monday through Thursday from 1:00 to 3:00 pm.

In operation since 1994, FOODLine was established in response to community needs when requests for food assistance began to overwhelm the HELPLine system. In the past 24 years, FOODline has served tens of thousands of families in the Huntsville area and the need for our help continues.

Responsibilities and qualifications:

- Enjoy people and ready to help those in need
- Good listening skills
- Basic computer skills (familiar with use of mouse, keyboard and printer)
- Confidentiality/willingness to protect clients' personal information
- Available to volunteer 2-4 mornings or afternoons per month
