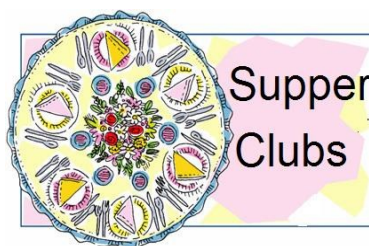
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
